Panelist Biographies

Neil Gouveia, Panel Moderator

Neil Gouveia began his career as an Assignment Desk Editor and Weekend Photographer for News12 the Bronx in 2003. He covered stories of all types of socio and political issues affecting the Bronx. He then landed a News Assistant position at FOX News in which he gained experience in the national and international news spectrum. He later joined the Dateline team at NBC as an Assistant Producer in which we he worked on a variety of stories ranging from Hurricane Katrina to the Perverted Justice segments. In 2008 Neil moved into the Public Relations industry and accepted a position as the Associate Director of Media Relations. He spearheaded the social media department and contributed articles and photos to the school's website and magazine. Currently, Neil is the Director of Alumni Affairs and engages graduates around the world to connect with their alma mater.

Jimmy Marsanico, The Muse

Jimmy's immersive background in computer engineering, machine learning, and biometric software has earned him the role as the primary Data Scientist at TheMuse.com. Mr. Marsanico uses data to determine which content is most successful, so as to improve readership loyalty and other key metrics. By analyzing how the users interact with the site, he is able to provide data-driven insights to the media company's product decisions, help grow the user audience, and even improve the sales efforts. While earning his master's degree from the College of Engineering at Carnegie Mellon University, he worked in a world-leading biometric center, developing software for facial recognition systems. Additionally, he worked in the Human Computer Interaction center, which focused on bringing technology into human hands as seamlessly as possible. He even conducted research around idea-propagation using over 100GB of Twitter data. These experiences carry over to The Muse by helping to seamlessly deliver digital content to users on a daily basis.

Ralph Nader, Viacom

Ralph Nader joined Viacom/MTV Networks in 2013 to support digital recruiting across Viacom's large portfolio of brands including MTV, VH1, Comedy Central, Nickelodeon, and Spike. This includes creative, editorial and technology functions. Prior to joining Viacom, Ralph spent a number of years at NBCUniversal where he was responsible for NBC News and NBC's Digital properties; a portfolio that included Bravo, Oxygen, MSNBC, CNBC, Fandango.com, and some of NBC's flagship News properties such as The Today Show, and Dateline. Prior to transitioning into the Media and Entertainment industry, Ralph began his career in advertising working as a Project Manager at one of Omnicom's most successful advertising agencies in New York. Shortly thereafter, he joined Bench International, a boutique- retained executive search firm, as their Director of Recruitment. A position he held for 3 years before joining the NBC News Group. Having been in recruiting and human resources across many industries, gives him a well-rounded perspective of talent management, recruitment and career planning. Ralph holds a degree from the University of Arizona in Sociology with thematic minors Psychology, Communication and Public Administration. He later completed graduate coursework in organizational development and leadership coaching at NYU. His passion has always been coaching and guiding new graduates in their quest to identify their passion and career paths. In addition, Ralph advises more experienced professionals looking to advance or change their career. Helping individuals reach their personal and professional goals remains at the core of all the work he does.

Tanya Valle, Cachet Public Relations

Cachet Public Relations founder, Tanya Valle has executed communications strategy at some of the most well known companies and contentious New York City agencies, under former Mayor Michael Bloomberg. Her sector experience includes social services, financial services, transactions, technology, oil & gas and advertising. As a native New Yorker, covering the City's news came easy. Tanya began her journalism career as an on-air reporter with News 12 The Bronx. She was later recruited by NY1 News shortly after the 9/11 attacks to report breaking news.
